## ADDITIONAL MUSICAL PERFORMANCES



Aiofe Clancy is an Irish folk musician who has performed with several Irish groups and has appeared with the Boston Pops and Cincinnati Pops.



A seasoned performer with over 33 years on the road, Rory has toured extensively with The Makem Brothers, and the Makem and Spain Brothers and for 17 years played guitar with his father, Tommy Makem. He has played sold-out venues, festivals, and theaters throughout the United States, Canada, England, Scotland and Ireland. At his best on stage, Rory captivates his audiences with charisma, passion for the songs, poetry, history, humor and skilled musicianship.



John Dady has been singing his way into the hearts of his audiences since the 1970's when he and his brother Joe produced their first album as "The Dady Brothers". Many more albums followed, along with thousands of live performances. They've shared their delightful music throughout the eastern United States and across Ireland. John and Joe's brotherly harmonies and adept command of a variety of instruments captivated audiences both young and old. In 2020, The Dady Brothers were chosen to be inducted into the Rochester Music Hall of Fame. Since Joe's untimely death in 2019, John has continued the tradition performing solo or with an array of accomplished musician friends.

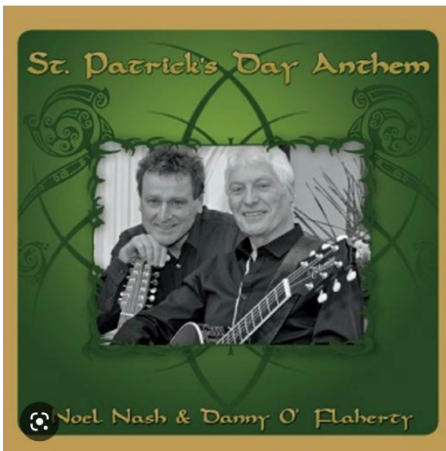


Although Geoff Kaufman is best known to a lot of people for his time at Mystic Seaport Museum in CT he has maintained a wide ranging repertoire from 60s favorites to songs collected in the Catskill Mountains where he grew up and from his time as a Sloopsinger with the Hudson River Sloop Clearwater and Pete Seeger.



The "Irish Lads", Tommy and Mike have been performing Irish Folk Music together for over 45 years.

Based in the coal region of Pennsylvania, the "Lads" have produced five musical recordings, and a video, always emphasizing humor, crowd participation and the history of Ireland.



Irish songwriter and musician Noel Nash was born and raised in County Limerick, Ireland, where he was educated by the Christian Brothers and then went on to study at the School of Music in Limerick. Early in his career, Noel met and formed a partnership with the renowned songwriter Pete St John and they performed and wrote together for 5 years. Noel's captivating vocals and stage present lead to a tour of the United states with a series of concerts in New York, Chicago and Washington D.C. In Washington, Noel joined the traditional Irish group "Celtic Folk" with brothers' Danny and Patrick O'Flaherty. The trio performed there for three years in the D.C. area appearing in local venues, festivals plus radio and television. In 1984 the group relocated to New Orleáns for the World's Fair and ended up staying and performing locally in New Orleáns for another 4

years. Today Noel lives in Ballybunion, County Kerry and when not playing Golf or Volunteering with "Tidy Towns, he performs in Ballybunnion at The Cliff House Hotel during the summer months. Noel also continues to tour in solo performances throughout Ireland and venues in the United States during the Winter months where he also occasionally teams up with his old band mate Danny O'Flaherty performing as the "The Celtic Sons". Noel's ability to create an intimate evening with the audience through his captivating stage presence and traditional musical mastery creates the atmosphere of being with friends at the local Irish pub wherever he performs.
